2. You must notify DMV within 5 days if you:
Sell or transfer your vehicle [X]
Are cited for a traffic violation []
Paint your vehicle a different color []
3. When you park on a level road next to a curb:
Your wheels must be within 18 inches of the curb [X]
Your front wheels must be turned towards the side of the road []
You do not have to set your parking brake []
4. If you always insist on letting other drivers go ahead of you at intersections, you are most likely:
